Processing of personal data in Code Flyers

The information you provide Code Flyers with when filling out forms on this site, such as your name and address, is required for us to handle your request. Security procedures have been established to protect your personal information from accidental access and use. We work to ensure that you always feel safe when you provide us with personal information. Below you will find information about the personal information collected, why we do this, and your rights related to the processing of the information.

1. Why do we collect personal information and what kind of information do we collect

We collect and use your personal information for various purposes depending on who you are and how we get in touch with you. We collect the following personal information for the purposes stated here:

1.1. Administration of information that you provide on the site and answering specific inquiries where personal information is required to assist you. This can typically be: Name, telephone number, email address and any personal information. The processing of personal data takes place based on a weighing of interest. Management of interest forms for projects, impressions and rectification of errors, marketing, and newsletters. The treatment is done based on an agreement with you.

1.2. The information collected in connection with impressions and improvements of errors can form the basis for market and customer analysis, market research and statistics. This information can also be processed to provide targeted information and promotion of offers. (This point is also mentioned earlier)

1.3. Recruitment for new positions. CV, application, certificates, and references. The processing of personal data is based on the consent you have given.

1.4. For information on using our website, we use cookies. You can read more about cookies and what cookies we use in the section below. We process personal information based on a weighing of interest. We do this to adapt the website to our users. However, we safeguard your privacy by using only the information for statistics. In these statistics it is not possible to identify yourself as an individual. We do not pass on your personal information to others unless there is a legal basis for such extradition. Examples of such a basis will typically be an agreement with you or a legal basis that requires us to disclose the information.

Code Flyers uses data processors to collect, store or otherwise process personal information on our behalf. In such cases, we have entered into agreements to safeguard the information security at all



stages of the treatment. All processing of personal data that we carry out takes place within the EU / EEA area.

2. Storage time

We store your personal information as long as it is necessary for the purpose of which the personal information was collected. Personal information we process to fulfill an agreement with you is deleted when the agreement and all obligations arising from the agreement are fulfilled.

3. Your rights when we process pesonal information about you

You have the right to:

- request access to your personal data and the right to rectify it, limit the processing of personal data or to delete it;
- to the extent that the basis for the processing of personal data is consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data at any time.
- object at any time to the processing of personal data:
- for reasons related to your situation, when the Code Flyers processes data for purposes arising from legitimate interests (Article 21 (1) of the GDPR),
- for purposes related to direct marketing, including profiling for marketing purposes to the extent that the processing of your data is related to direct marketing (Article 21 (2) of the GDPR);
- requests to transfer personal data processed for the purpose of concluding and performing a contract or processed based on consent. The transfer consists of receiving from the Code Flyers your personal data in a structured, commonly used machine-readable format and sending such data to another data administrator.
- submitting a complaint to the supervisory body, i.e., to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, if it is found that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.

4. Changes

In case of changes of our services or of the Personal Data Regulations we will notify you of this, should we have your contact information. Updated information will always be available on our website.

Cookies

When using our site, some information may be stored on your computer in the form of a "cookie". A cookie is a small text file that is transferred from the site to your hard drive or browser. This gives us information about when and how long you were on our website, which pages you read and which website you visited before you came to our site. We can also see which Internet service provider and browser you are using and whether you visit our website using a computer, mobile phone or tablet. We use this information to customize the content to better suit your expectations and to see how we can improve our information offer on www.codeflyers.com. Cookies can also be used to make ads and other content more relevant. In some browsers you can change the settings so that you do not receive cookies or receive a message when it happens. If you do not want your browser to accept cookies, please use the help function in your browser to read how to change these settings. However, please note that you may not be able to fully utilize the website's functionality. Statistics this site uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses "cookies" to analyze how visitors use the website. The information generated by the cookie through your use of the website (including your IP address) will be communicated to and stored by Google on servers in the United States.
